They work with the F.F.E., with the support of the Haras Nationaux and the Defence Ministry.


Its missions consist in:



- All participants should have acquired a level that allows them to take part in official competitions (level M)

#### Aim:

- Train the student to be a professional riding Instructor qualified with the **B**revet **P**rofessionnel de la **J**eunesse, de l'**E**ducation **P**opulaire et des **S**ports (BP JEPS), European level 4 and international level 2 diploma (IGEQ).



#### Syllabus:

The syllabus is designed in technique pedagogy and theory in the different equestrian disciplines.

Every student will ride 3 horses per day, one in each Olympic discipline teach by the Ecuyers of the Cadre Noir.

#### 1. Payment procedure:

Total International Riding Instructor Course costs: 15 500 €/year

Horse accommodation charges cost 350,00 € (\*) per horse and per month. Supplement of 6,50 €/day (\*) for artificial.litter.

Deposit must be paid only after the selection (no transfer for the application for admission). It cost 5 500 € by bank transfer.

#### Forbidden:

You don't have to send us the first deposit before the decision of the selection committee

The settlement must be paid in three terms:

1<sup>st</sup> term:

3 300 € latest on the 15/12/2013

2<sup>nd</sup> term:

3 300 € latest on the 15/03/2014

3<sup>rd</sup> term:

3 400 € latest on the 15/06/2014

The payment of deposit within the allocated deadline period is a necessary and compulsory condition to have your enrolment recognized.

If you do not respect the deadline for the payment during the course, your course will be automatically stopped after three reminders.

#### 2. Changes or cancellation

In case of any changes, adjustment or cancellation of the course, you must inform the E.N.E. by mail. The financial conditions can be changed in case of medical difficulty exceeding more than 3 weeks.

The deposit paid is always kept in case of withdrawal before or during the course.


